

Holdings Manager offers data services for maintaining online holdings information your catalog, tracking changes to your online collections, updating your proxy configuration, and more. Data can be provided on a weekly or monthly basis in a variety of file formats and delivery options.



MARC Records

Holdings Manager data can include CONSER MARC records or TDNet "brief" records. The data files can be customized to include a unique record number from the customer's catalog, which will be included in all data files for easy record matching.

Other customization options include...

- **Record types:** CONSER or brief MARC.
- **CONSER format:** Either CONSER Option B (a single record containing all full text sources/links for an e-journal) or a separate record for each title/source.
- **CONSER Heading Options:** Option to add genre headings in the 655 field; removing the 510 field; or adding special subject headings to the 953 field.
- **TDNet Brief Heading Options:** Option to add special subject headings to the 953 field.
- **Maintenance Types:** Full data file

Holdings Manager is available as a stand-alone service or in combination with other TDNet services, including:

NISO-compliant software package that links from reference databases to full text of OpenURL and non-OpenURL target resources. Offers fast setup and an integrated TOC service for enhanced link resolving and article-level linking.

Solution for central access and management of your e-journal and ebook collections, with weekly and real-time holdings updates, interface customization, usage statistics, and an optional TOC collection featuring end-user current awareness tools;

Other Data Options

Holdings Manager also offers the following data service options:

- **Excel/Delimited Data:** An alternative to MARC records, holdings data can be delivered in Excel or other delimited format with standard bibliographic and e-journal holdings information. Full Files or ChangeNotes are available.
- **EZ-Proxy Update:** data files for updating your EZ-Proxy or other proxy services with the latest URL, domain, and host information to ensure that all your e-resources are available to remote users .
- **OCLC eSerials Holdings Service:** Data files sent to OCLC to load your holdings data into WorldCat.
- **Database Comparisons:** A valuable collection management tool for



ChangeNotes

ChangeNotes offers a unique approach to simplifying the data update process by providing data files that are broken into three categories: Titles Added, Titles Removed, and Titles Changed.

Because ChangeNotes only provides data for titles that have undergone a change, the library can update the catalog faster and more efficiently.
